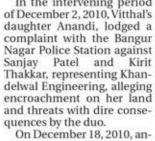

The judge directed the Registrar to file a written state-ment under Sections 191, 192, 193, 196, 199, 200, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471 and 474 of Indian Penal Code, against the company's directors, including Sanjay Patel.

The case dates backs to the year 2001, when a tiller Vitthal Koli, owning a agriculplot land admeasuring 3 acre/39 guntha (Survey No 26, Plot No 15, 16 and 17) at Mauje Valnai, Malwani (now near existing Evershine Nagar), died on February 7, 2001, leaving behind him six legal heirs 1. Babytai Vitthal Koli (wife), 2. Anandi Shivram Koli (married daughter), 3. Mahadeo Vitthal Koli (son), 4. Kashibai Suresh Koli (married daughter), 5. Krushna Vitthal Koli (son) and 6. Lata Hareshwar Bhandari (married daughter).

However, the company directors, allegedly obtained a consent decree to take over the land under coercion and threats to illiterate widow Babytai and her sons Mahadeo and Krishna without any settlement or payment on June 25, 2002. The present market price of the plot is above Rs 500 crore.

Then a suit (No BCCC suit No 5026/2007) was filed by Mahadev Vitthal's son against Vinod Sharma, one of the directors of Khandelwal Engineering. Subsequently Sharma expired.

The respondents company in an affidavit filed on De-cember 28, 2010, stated that there were only three legal heirs of late Vitthal and therefore the consent term dated June 25, 2002 was correct. The land was non-agricultural and it was in possession of the company from 1970 till 2010, the company claimed.

on the said consent terms. Therefore the consent term was incorrect. The judge also referred to the talathis's recent report dated April 19, 2014, which specifically mentioned Vitthal left behind six legal heirs.

The judge stated that "from the above material, it is crystal clear that father of the ap-(Babytai) cultivating the suit land be-fore "Tillers Day" (i.e. April 1, 1957) and he was declared Tenant". The tehsildar, had also fixed the purchase price of the land as per order dated

Despite a delayed start, the ongoing repair and maintenance work of the Mumbai-bound Versova Creek bridge remains on track and is expected to be completed by the originally projected date of December 25, set by the National High-Authority of India (NHAI).

The crucial bridge - which links Mumbai to Gujarat, New Delhi and other major cities - has been under repairs since December 8. Originally the month long work was scheduled to begin on November 26, as per the official government notification.

Confident of completing the work within the stipulated deadline, despite a delayed start, a senior NHAI official said, "While one side of the bridge has been repaired, work is going on in full swing on the other side. We expect to complete the entire work by December 25. The bridge will be in a fully



operational mode after a

thorough inspection." While light motor vehicles are allowed to use only one side of the two-lane Mumbai-bound bridge, heavy vehicles which have been completely barred from using the bridge are being directed via the Manor-Wada-Bhiwandi-Thane and Shirsat Phata-Ganeshpuri-Vrajeshwari-Bhiwandi-Thane routes. This apart from an option of using the Chinchoti-Kaman-Anjur Phata-Bhiwandi-Thane route, Traffic Police personnel said.
